NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: The 2019 Nyack Boat Club Fall Regatta is organized by Lightning Fleet #75.

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of US SAILING, the respective Class Rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any amendments thereto.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Nyack Boat Club One-Design (Ensign, Ideal 18, Laser, Lightning, Open, Sonar, Thistle, Viper and 420 fleets and Cruising Fleets. Eligibility for entry shall be in accordance with the Class Rules of each participating Class.
- 2.2 Registration will occur at the Nyack Boat Club on Saturday, September 7, 2018. See SCHEDULE for times. Registration and in-person check-in are mandatory before the Competitors Meeting.

Awards at NBC after racing

- 4.1 Each one-design class with at least three boats participating will have a separate start. All other boats will start with the Open Fleet. The starting order will be determined by the Race Committee as described in the Sailing Instructions.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Nyack Boat Club Holiday Sailing Instructions will be used and are posted on the NBC website (www.nyackboatclub.org). Limited copies will be available during registration and check-in. The sailing instructions include holiday course diagrams.

6 VENUE

Races will be sailed in the Tappan Zee of the Hudson River

7 SCORING

8.1 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A2, modified as follows: "A boat's regatta score will be the total of all her race scores".

8.2 One race completed constitutes a regatta for each fleet.

8 RADIO COMMUNICATION

VHF Radios are permitted, as specified in the Sailing Instructions.

Prizes will be awarded to the top skippers and crewmembers in each Fleet
