

# Nyack Boat Club: Guest Moorings and Transients

July 23, 2020

Location:

- By Land: 59 Gedney Street, Nyack, NY
- By Water: 41 05' 32" N 73 54' 49"W **(about 1.2 miles Northwest of Tappan Zee Bridge Channel)**

Nyack Boat Club welcomes visitors and has six (6) guest moorings available for transients making their way up or down the Hudson River. Guest moorings are available at a small charge for either day use or overnight.

We take reservations for guest moorings only via Dockwa.om. Space is usually available, even at the last minute, except during a large-scale regatta when out-of-town regatta participants may occupy all the guest moorings ([see our calendar](#)).

Depth at low tide:

- 10+ ft. at all guest moorings
- 6+ ft. at our touch-and-go dock (east end of pier)
- 5 ft. at our outer finger dock (south side of pier)
- 6+ ft. at our mast dock (north side of pier)

Guest moorings can be found in the southeast corner of our mooring field. Each one has a pendant mooring buoy (cylinder shape, not a ball, with two pendants laid on top, out of the water – see image, some complete with a pick-up stick).

- If mooring does not have a pick-up stick, please replace pendants on top of mooring.
- If mooring has a pick-up stick, please be sure to clip both loops to the pick-up stick.

**Guest moorings have two ratings: heavy and light. Heavy rated moorings are painted on the top with orange and have minimum chain weights of 3/4" and 5/8", with one using a 1000lb anchor with 1" and 3/4" chain (O3). Orange should be used for boats 35' and larger. The lighter rated moorings are painted green and have 1/2" top chain attached to either 5/8" or 3/4" bottom chain. The minimum weight of anchors of all guest moorings are 500lb DorMors.**



Following is a chart of the southeast corner of the Nyack Boat Club mooring field. You may use this chart to identify the locations of 6 guest moorings. The neighboring permanent member moorings, if any, are identified by boat type and boat name as an aid. Note, the moorings are in a zig-zag patten within the grid, as indicated.

### Guest Mooring Procedure

The Nyack Boat Club Launch monitors VHF Channel 9. All mooring reservations and payments should be made using Dockwa.com. You may contact our launch operator when you arrive for final instructions or questions about your guest mooring. We offer launch service from May through October – from mid-May to mid-September the launch operates Monday – Friday, 4 pm to 9 pm, and Saturday/Sunday 9 am to 9 pm. You can find the most current launch schedule on our website at [www.nyackboatclub.org](http://www.nyackboatclub.org). We make every effort to keep this schedule up to date.

If you arrive when our launch is not in service, you may register for your guest mooring using Dockwa.com, and later confirm your arrival with our launch operator.

**NOTE:** When you depart, please be sure to lay pendants on top of mooring buoy, dry and out of the water, if the mooring has a pick-up stick. If not, please be sure to clip both loops to the pick-up stick.

Please confirm with our launch operator how long you intend to stay, and the launch operator will complete your check-in on Dockwa.com. Once ashore, at the clubhouse please be sure to sign our guest register (in the front hall).

We limit use of our guest mooring to 5 consecutive nights.

Note for members of HRYRA clubs only, we offer complimentary use of our guest mooring for one night at a time.

## Use of Club Facilities

Guests are invited to make use of our facilities, including our launch service.

**Note: No fuel. No marine head pumpout.** Freshwater and 120V power available at our finger docks. Guests may not tie up at our finger docks except to take on water. If you have a dinghy, you may make use of our dinghy dock (north side of pier).

At the clubhouse you'll find ice (self-service, please leave cash in the box), bathrooms and showers, vending machines, and our snack bar (May through September; Wednesday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and occasionally other days). Feel free to use the picnic area and grills. Please do not use the kitchen.

Dogs and pets are not allowed on Club property except on leash being taken directly to or from a boat.

## Easy Access to Nyack and New York City

The Village of Nyack is an easy walk up the hill from the club. Within walking distance, you'll find many restaurants and shops, including local markets for provisions and a hardware store. Lots of useful information at <http://visitnyack.org>

Nearest car rental is Enterprise (845-353-3222), about ½ mile away.

You can reach New York City from Nyack by bus via [Rockland Coach](#) (Routes 9A, 9T, 9W) to either the GWB Terminal or Port Authority Terminal, or by the [TZX bus](#) to Tarrytown to connect to the MetroNorth commuter train to Grand Central Station.

[Samalot Marine](#) (marine store and services at Haverstraw Marina, 845-429-0404) are in Haverstraw, 10 miles north, and a roughly \$20 taxi ride (each way). Nyack Taxi: 845-358-4444; Haverstraw Taxi: 845-947-4747; or Uber.
